DISCUSSION ITEMS

Discussed closure of Macey's Grocery Store.

2018 Ideas:

Dog Park
Heritage Days – talked about what to hand out at the booth. Bev & Justin can work on getting seedlings. Darryl will contact the Weber Water Basin to get items again.
Heritage Days will be July 12-14.
Pickle ball or bocce ball – Fix up old tennis court at Meadows Park.

City received a \$90,000 anonymous donation. We will need to discuss this. The City Council will decide what to do with the donation.. Under the city budget, improvement must be used for “public purpose”.

Agenda for City Council meeting for January 23rd is action packed.

Two council members support moving the Veteran's memorial to the new trail park across from Heritage Park.

A \$100,000 grant has been received and some changes have already been made at 2300 North and 1300 North. We'll have to use the money or give it back. The money can't be used for the Veteran's memorial – it wasn't in the original plans.

The Powerline Park problem is closer to being resolved. An amended proposal with a new appraisal of the property has been drawn up. There are detached parcels because of the road that has to go in. There is also the purchase of a perpetual easement.

The plat for the new park area has not been approved yet.

A new water line going in on 2300 North with a possible water tank. There is no time frame yet for the bridge on 2300 North.

Pond Park – no action on monthly money. Use fees are going to the new park and to Powerline.
