Approval of the Minutes for: Aug 18, 2022 and September 15, 2022. Motion to accept the minutes: Kathy Ostberg, Seconded: Kellie Cowley.

Community Book Club: Six people have been attending. We have chosen the books for next year. The question was asked about whether the building needs to be scheduled for next year. We talked about reserving the building the first Tuesday of the month from 7-8 pm, but if an opportunity to rent the building at that time comes up, we could hold the Book Club at another location that month. Facebook: We will get the Bards and Nobles advertising posted.

Children's Choir: The choir will perform for the Clinton "Blitzen Blast" on December 5th and at Country Pines on November 30th at 5:30 pm. Kellie expressed concerns about liability issues with children leaving on their own. If children live nearby, it is probably not our concern that they walk. Laretta said someone should stay until all the children have been picked up.

The Clinton winter activity has been named the "Blitzen Bash". The activities for the evening will include Santa, a real reindeer, crafts, music groups and refreshments. Kellie will work on getting 500 cookies donated by Lofthouse. She will pick them up on Nov. 29th and bring them to the recreation building.

Valens message was also read. She offered to work on a competitor audit for the Arts Board. We do have a mission statement for the Arts board, it is on the Clinton City Recreation website.
