FIREWORKS SAFETY

Please keep in mind that fireworks contain explosive materials, dangerous chemicals and combustibles that can destroy property and harm or cause death to unsuspecting victims. These deceptively simple objects explode throwing unburned powder, hot sparks and embers through the air at high velocities and often create temperatures hotter than 1,200 degrees Fahrenheit. Please be sure to follow the following firework safety tips:

- Purchase fireworks from reliable, licensed fireworks dealers. Read all instructions to reduce the chances of a destructive fire or debilitating injury.
- Follow all safety guidelines exactly. Children should not handle fireworks. You must be at least 16 years of age to handle or light fireworks. Adults are to supervise any activity that includes fireworks.
- Never let children handle, play with or light fireworks. Only knowledgeable and clear-headed adults should handle fireworks.
- Adults should never use alcohol or drugs or be impaired while engaged in handling, using, placing or lighting fireworks.
- Aerial devices need at least 30 foot clearance on the ground and as much as 150 feet in the air.
- Never shoot fireworks in windy conditions.
- Keep a bucket of water or running hose nearby during lighting and disposing of fireworks and in case of an emergency.
- Use caution with animals. Excitement, noise and lights can cause fear and stress.

Please remember State Law allows the discharge of fireworks 3 days before and 3 days after the 4th and 24th of July between the hours of 11 a.m. and 11 p.m. except on July 4th and July 24th the hours are 11 a.m. to Midnight. You can also discharge fireworks on New Year's Eve and Chinese New Year between the hours of 11 a.m. and 1 a.m. Fireworks are an American tradition. Safety and common sense are important as we celebrate the holidays with fireworks.

Contact Football - DEADLINE is JULY 8TH!! Only COMPLETE packets are accepted. WE ARE NOT PROVIDING PHYSICAL EXAMS THIS YEAR. Ages 7-15, must weigh at least 40 lbs and not be registered for high school. Cost is \$110. Packets can be picked up in our office or found online and must be completed upon registration.

Flag Football: Co-ed ages 1st-9th grade. Cost is \$50 resident and \$55 non-resident. Deadline July 29th

Fall Soccer Registration - Registration runs from June 1st – July 29th. Cost is \$50.00 for Residents and \$55.00 for Non-Residents. The season runs August - October.
