**A MESSAGE FROM OUR WATER DEPARTMENT**

Since last August all water samples & chlorine residuals tested have been satisfactory. The Water Department continues to install dual check devices & service existing valves throughout the City. We would like to remind you that it is illegal to connect the secondary water supply to the culinary water system. If you have any questions about Cross connections please contact the Public Works Department at 801 614 0870.

The Secondary Water Service will be discontinued as of October 15.

**WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS** will go into effect November 15 through March 15. No on street parking is allowed from 12 am to 7 am regardless of the weather.
