



### **A MESSAGE FROM PUBLIC WORKS ABOUT SNOW PLOWS**

Our snow plow crews do their best to clear the roads after a storm. As a reminder, higher traveled streets (collector roads) will be plowed first, with special attention to hills and difficult intersections. Subdivision streets, cul-de-sacs and dead ends will be plowed after with smaller trucks.

When plows are active in your area please keep a safe distance from the road. And, especially now that there is already some snow accumulation, please make sure children do not play in the snow banks or near the roads where they could be injured with the passing snow plows and or vehicles sliding on slick roads.

As a reminder, after the plows have passed, the City Ordinance states that Clinton City property owners are responsible for keeping sidewalks along their property or business clear of snow and ice and prohibits anyone from depositing snow into public roads.

Winter Parking is in effect November 15th to March 15th. NO OVERNIGHT PARKING is allowed from midnight to 7:00 am no matter what the snow conditions are. During a snow event please don't park on the street either to allow easier passage of the snow plows. Contact the Police Dept at 801-614-0800 with questions.

Winter driving can be unpredictable. Please pay attention to road conditions, be patient and drive safely. Thank you!!

### **HEATING SAFETY TIPS**

Heating equipment is a leading cause of home fire deaths. Almost half of home heating equipment fires are reported during the months of December, January, and February. Some simple steps can prevent most heating-related fires from happening.

- Keep anything that can burn at least three feet away from heating equipment, like the furnace, fireplace, wood stove, or portable space heater.
- Have a three-foot "kid-free zone" around open fires and space heaters.
- Never use your oven to heat your home.
- Have a qualified professional install stationary space heating equipment, water heaters or central heating equipment according to the local codes and manufacturer's instructions.
- Have heating equipment and chimneys cleaned and inspected every year by a qualified professional.
- Remember to turn portable heaters off when leaving the room or going to bed.
- Always use the right kind of fuel, specified by the manufacturer, for fuel burning space heaters.
- Make sure the fireplace has a sturdy screen to stop sparks from flying into the room. Ashes should be cool before putting them in a metal container. Keep the container a safe distance away from your home.
- Test smoke alarms monthly.
