Look for City Services Fees to increase in August

For many years, there have not been increases in many City utility service fees. However each service by law must financially stand on its own (as if it were a privately owned company). In order to balance these funds, a few of the fees must be increased. Starting July 1, 2008, the monthly Sewer and Storm Drain fees will each increase \$1/month. The Garbage fees will increase \$.90 for the 1st can, and \$.25 for each additional can. And lastly (though it is controlled by a separate company, the billing is found on your monthly water bill), the Secondary Water rate will increase \$.25 per month for the lowest rate payers and increase proportionately. We will continue to maintain the City fee rates as low as possible.

LANDSCAPE REQUIRED FOR FRONT YARDS

Effective as of Feb 2007, all existing homes and new homes have 18 months within which to have their front yards landscaped. This will be enforced as of Aug 2008.

BE SAFE WITH FIREWORKS!!!!

Clinton City Fire Officials would like to remind our citizens of a few safety tips when using fireworks this July

- Fireworks may be discharged 3 days before and /or 3 days after; July 4th, July 24th, and January 1st or the Chinese New Year.
- Always have adult supervision when lighting fireworks and use common sense. Please follow the directions.
- Do not discharge fireworks closer than 20 feet from your residence.
- Make sure your fireworks are legal in Utah. It is a Class "C" misdemeanor for a person to sell, discharge or to have illegal fireworks in their possession.

Kids in the Park

Kids in the Park for children ages 5-12 years old – Mon - Thur 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. now thru August 14th; children may sign up to participate on a monthly or daily basis.

Contact Football

Youth ages 7 to 15 (with some restrictions) can sign up to play WFFL football through Clinton Recreation. Registration runs thru July 18th at the Recreation office. Cost for the program is \$90. To register you must bring your 1) Birth Certificate, 2) Proof of Medical Insurance (medical card), 3) Proof of residency (i.e., water bill); 4) \$90 Registration fee. Also...each participant must have a physical within the last 6 months or have a physical prior to July 28th. All Clinton and Sunset residents MUST sign up in Clinton; this is a league By-Law. Youth Soccer

Registration for youth fall soccer will begin July 1st and continue thru July 21st. This soccer program is for children Pre-School age (year before they enter Kindergarten) through 6th grade. The fee is \$40 for residents and includes a jersey, shorts, socks games and practices.

CLINTON CITY RECYCLING PROGRAM

Clinton City has two large recycling bins located in the street in front of the City Public Works Shops at 1740 N. and 1700 W., behind Centennial Bank. One large bin is for newspaper and cardboard. The other is for plastic. These bins have been available for many years, and they get filled up regularly. The bins are emptied approximately three times per week by Wasatch Integrated Energy Systems (burn plant & landfill). Please abide by the following rules to allow everyone the opportunity to use the bins:

- Only put the designated recyclable items in the appropriate bin. Appropriate items are:
 - Numbers 1 and 2 Plastics (On the bottom of every plastic container is a number within a triangle. That number determines plastic type.)
 - Cardboard (For cardboard, break it down and flatten it out to fit inside the bin more effectively.)
 - Steel and Aluminum Cans
 - Newspapers, phone books and magazines
- If the bins are full, **Do Not** leave anything outside of the bin. Please **do not** deposit your household garbage or non recyclable items inside or outside the bins.

There is no charge to deposit recyclable material in the bins. Please use these recycling bins for their correct purposes and help keep the City looking clean. For other Davis County bin locations please visit their website at www.wasatchintegrated.org and click on "find recycling drop off bin locations" on the home page.

The Public Works Department also accepts tree branches for chipping on Monday and Thursdays from 1 pm to 3 pm and on Saturdays from 8 am to 10 am. If you have any questions please contact them at 774-2690 M-F 7 am to 3:30 pm.

Week-end Animal Control Services

Davis County Sheriff's Office provides Animal Control Services for Clinton City. Due to the level of demand, limited week-end service begins in July. Service hours will be between 8am and 5pm. The service is really for emergency type calls. Calls for service will be prioritized based on the following emergencies:

- animal bites;
- dogs attacking livestock;
- injured animals;
- loose livestock;
- D.U.I. impounding;
- vicious animals; and,
- animals interfering with Official functions.

Non-emergency calls may be postponed, depending on the volume of emergency type calls. Davis Council Dispatch Center, (801) 451-4150, is the number for animal related calls.

Clinton City Youth Council 2008


