IMPORTANT FIRE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

New Non-Emergent 48 Hr Gas Detection Program Now Available:

The Clinton City Fire Department has just implemented this program for residential and commercial occupancies.

The intent is to help identify the presence of several invisible and potentially harmful gases that may be present within the home or workplace.

This program utilizes equipment specifically designed to identify the presence of Carbon Monoxide; Radon Gas / Radiation; Propane Gas and Methane Gas.

The kit only takes a few minutes to install and is easily removed without leaving any traces of its placement.

Please contact the Clinton City Fire Department at (801) 614-0840 to schedule a brief appointment with our on-duty staff. We have only 1 kit available at this time and anticipate heavy usage of this equipment.

All detection equipment was donated to the Clinton City Fire Department by **Elite Fire Enterprises**, a Utah based company that specializes in high quality gas & smoke detection systems.

This program is not designed for emergent situations. If you suspect the presence of dangerous levels of carbon monoxide gases or any other gas that may create an Immediate Danger to Life or Health, leave the area immediately and call 911!

If for any reason you did not receive a renewal please contact Community Development at 801-614-0740 and we will be happy to mail you one. (Business license fees for renewal businesses shall be due and payable on or before January 1 of each year and shall be delinquent after February 1 of each year.)

10 Christmas Tree Safety Tips to Remember:

- Ensure your tree has a fresh cut at the base of it before placing it in water
- Place in a reservoir-type tree stand designed to accommodate your tree
- Water your tree daily
- Never use extension cords or lights with frayed cords or empty sockets
- Use mini lights or LED lights when ever possible as they produce less heat
- Turn off all Christmas lights prior to leaving your home or going to bed.
- Safely dispose of your tree before it become dangerously dry. If needles start falling from the tree, its time to dispose of it!
- Never burn your tree or any part of it in a fire place, byproducts from the tree may lead to a chimney fire
- Avoid using open-flame candles whenever possible
- Test your smoke detectors as per manufacturers instructions

COMMUNITY RENTAL ROOM ACCEPTING RESERVATIONS!

Reservations are taken at the Clinton Recreation Administration Building at 1651 W 2300 N on a first come, first served basis and must be made in person. The rental fee is paid at the time of reservation and the deposit is paid on the last working day prior to the rental when the key is picked up. The rental room is 25' X 38' and has a kitchen attached to it as well as an outdoor patio area. The rental rate is \$40 per hour plus a \$250 refundable deposit. The rental fee includes tables and chairs for up to 75 people.

In addition, the Recreation Department has a training room connected to the rental area. On weekends (Friday Night, Saturday and Sunday) when the training room is not in use, it can also be used for rentals. The Community Room with the Training Room measures 25' X 66'. The rental rate for both rooms is \$60 per hour plus a \$250 refundable deposit. Rental fee includes chairs and tables for up to 130 people. Rental rooms will NOT be available Christmas Day, New Years Eve or New Years Day.
