IMPORTANT INFORMATION.....

Many residents are frequently using the recycle bins located on the street between Centennial Bank and the Public Works office at approximately 1750 w 1700 n. and most are being responsible and following the rules. However, as you can see from this picture taken over the holidays, it only takes a few careless users to make a very large mess! Leaving recyclables or trash anywhere except inside the the actual recycling bins may be in violation of multiple City laws and prosecutable as a "Class C" misdemeanor. The bins are owned and operated by a private company at no cost to the City. When using the bins, please follow these simple rules so that we can continue to have this convenient service in the future. 1. Put only the following items inside the appropriate bin: milk, water and pop containers, aluminum and tin cans, newspaper, phonebooks, magazines and cardboard. 2. Items **not** accepted are glass, Styrofoam, wood or **TRASH**. 3. Place all items inside the bins, **not** on the bins or on the ground around the bins. If the bins are completely full, do not leave your items, but return later after the bins have been emptied. The usual schedule for the bins to be emptied is every Monday, Wednesday and Friday but again, this schedule is not controlled by the City.
