

## New Cemetery Fee Schedule

The City Council has passed a resolution establishing new fees for the Clinton City Cemetery. The fees have remained the same since 1994, but due to inflation, it has become necessary to increase the fees. ## Portable Carport Structures

Recently, the city building inspectors have found an increasing number of portable "carport type" structures throughout Clinton City. These structures typically consist of aluminum tubing with either a metal; fiberglass or canvas cover and are used to protect individual RV's, boats and other passenger type vehicles.

The purpose of this article is to notify both property owners and suppliers in the Clinton City area that these structures are not permitted within the city, unless the property owner first applies for a building permit. Application for a permit will only be accepted if the following criteria are met:

1. A site-plan must be submitted for review by the planning division to ensure proper location of the structure(s) in relation to the home. These requirements include, but are not limited to: a) Must be the required distance from primary structure (dwelling) for the zone. b) Shall meet the front yard and side yard setback for the zone. c) If located in the rear yard, the portable carport(s) (accessory structure) shall be three (3) feet from the rear and side property lines.
2. The property owner must provide engineering, which indicates how the structure(s) will be secured in order to meet the 90-mph wind speed required for the area.
3. The property owner must provide engineering, which indicates the covering used on the structure has been designed for the snow load required for the area (30 lb.).

Our goal is for property owners and suppliers to avoid the unnecessary return of these products due to being unable to complete the installation in accordance with local code and ordinance.

If you have placed one or more of these structures on your lot/property without a building permit and/or do not comply with the requirements noted above, you must notify the Community Development Department at 801-774-2620. Please feel free to contact the Community Development Department if you have any questions regarding this matter.

## **Reserving a Park Bowery or Meeting Room**

Just a reminder, Clinton City currently has boweries at 3 parks that may be reserved as well as a meeting room at the adult softball complex. Please contact the Recreation Department for more information at 774- 2666. Facilities are reserved on a first come first serve basis and you must reserve facilities in person, fill out a contract and make payment at the time of reservation.

- Due to construction of the new City Park, the City Park bowery and softball complex room will only be available until July 30, 2007.
