## 2011 Municipal Elections

The following candidates have filed for the 2011 Clinton City Municipal Election: Three 4 year term City Council seats are up for election.

Brice K. Mitchell	Michael Petersen
Cheri Reed (incumbent)	Anna L. Stanton (Incumbent)
Anthony O. "Tony" Thompson	Vernon S. Warner

Because there are only six (6) candidates, there will not be a Primary Election. The General Election will take place on Tuesday, November 8, 2011.



The Clinton City Mayor and City Council would like to encourage all the citizens of Clinton to voice their opinions about the proposed development of 1800 North. UDOT is conducting an environmental study and all are encouraged to go to the project web site at [www.udot.utah.gov/1800north/](http://www.udot.utah.gov/1800north/) and provide written comment, there is also a link on the Clinton City Web Site [www.clintoncity.net](http://www.clintoncity.net). Your opinion will be invaluable in helping UDOT and the study team establish a recommendation for the study on such items as the number of lanes, width of 1800 North, an overpass at the UP and Front Runner tracks, an interchange at I-15, and connection with the Falcon Hill development on the west side of Hill AFB. All citizens are also encouraged to attend an Open House, related to the project, where the study team will present design options and considerations that have been or are being evaluated in relation to the plan. **The Open House will be held August 4, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Sunset City Hall, located at 200 West 1300 North in Sunset.** Comments will be accepted at the Open House as well as the web site. This is your opportunity to express your opinion and make a difference in the future of the City pertaining to an event that could change the look and feel of the City forever.

## Clinton City Street Department Reminders for Use of Public Right-of-Ways & Parking Strips

Ordinance 25-3-1 states that all public right-of-way in the city shall be maintained in such a condition as to enhance the aesthetic appearance of the City. Accordingly, the following uses and restrictions shall apply:

- All shrubs and trees shall be pruned and maintained to permit plain view by person owning the property. Shrubs shall be pruned so as to not overhang the curb or sidewalk. Trees shall be pruned, so as to not overhang the street, to a height of twelve (12) feet or the sidewalk to a height of eight (8) feet, both measured from the top back of curb.
- No basketball standards, recreation structures or other similar items that may entice children or others to play or gather within the right-of-way shall be constructed or placed within or adjacent to the right-of-way.


