CITIZENS WANTED

Clinton City is looking for individuals who would like to serve the Community. There are two (2) positions in each of the following governmental bodies, which may need to be filled:

- Planning Commission
- Board of Zoning Adjustments

These positions are appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council

Planning Commission - meets the first & third Tuesday of each month. Positions are three (3) year terms. This body reviews Commercial Site plans, Subdivision Plats, Conditional Use Permits, and make recommendations to the City Council on Zoning Ordinance changes.

Board of Zoning Adjustments - meets whenever needed, usually on a Tuesday. Positions are five (5) year terms. This is a Quasi-judicial body, which reviews requests for variances from the Zoning Ordinance.

WEST DAVIS CORRIDOR UPDATE
