


A MESSAGE FROM MAYOR ADAMS ON CITY FUNDING:

Beginning in July, you will notice a County Dispatch fee and a County Animal Control fee in your water utility billing. The dispatching service is provided by Davis County for Fire and Police emergency services and is essential. This is a new fee started by the County a few years ago. The animal control services are also provided by Davis County, fees for these services have increased greatly in the past several years. The City has struggled paying these extra fees over these past few years without increasing taxes or fees to cover them. However, the continuing economic climate is forcing the need for a minor amount of increased revenue to offset these costs. Subsequently the City Council has approved my recommendation to establish these fees. The new fees will be restricted in use to only pay for the County Dispatch and Animal Control costs. The anticipated fee for dispatch service will be about \$0.95 per month and the anticipated fee for animal control will be about \$0.65 per month. Please know that the City Council and I know that these fee increases come at a time when the family's budget is already strained. Please know that we are committed to controlling the cost of city government. Thank you for bearing with us through these difficult times.

2011 Municipal Elections

Three 4-year term City Council seats are up for re-election in 2011. Election information can be found on the Clinton City web site at www.clintoncity.net. Persons wishing to be a candidate must: Be a registered voter; Have resided within Clinton City for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the November election date; and; Not have been convicted of treason or a felony and lost the right to vote.

A city resident may become a candidate for the City Council by either: Declaring Candidacy with the City Manager (signing the form) and paying a \$25.00 fee; or, Obtaining a Nomination Petition from the City Manager's office and getting 25 or more qualified signatures (Clinton residents 18 yrs of age or older)-No Fee.

Petitions or declarations for candidacy can only be filed with the City Manager from **July 1st to July 15th**, as set by State Code. All petitions or declarations must be correctly completed and returned to the City before 5:00 P.M. on July 15, 2011.

800 North Improvements Underway

Beginning June 6, Construction of roadway improvements along 800 North between 1000 West in Clinton and 2000 West in West Point will be underway. Key project features include pavement reconstruction and widening; continuous curb, gutter, sidewalk and storm drain; utility upgrades; and traffic signal installation at the intersection of 800 North/1000 West. The new roadway will have two, 12-foot travel lanes (one lane in each direction) and nine-foot shoulders. Project completion is expected by fall 2011.

To expedite project completion and as a safety precaution during construction, 800 North is closed to through traffic between 1000 West and 2000 West. Access is being maintained for local traffic only. Through traffic is detoured to 300 North and 1300 North.
