Business License Renewal

Business license fees for renewal businesses shall be due and payable on or before January 1 of each year and shall be delinquent after February 1 of each year. If the fee plus penalty is still not paid by March 1, a penalty of 75 percent of the amount of the fee shall be added to the original amount due. If the fee plus penalty is still not paid by April 1, then the business shall be considered to be operating without a business license in violation of Title 15, subject to criminal prosecution for every day of operation after January 1, if a license is issued thereafter the fee shall be double.

Youth Recreation and Softball Leagues

Rookie League for 5 year olds

In conjunction with our youth baseball / softball program, we will offer a rookie league program for 5 year olds. The rookie league is a pre T-ball program designed to prepare children for the experience of organized sports and learn the basic fundamentals of baseball and softball. Parents will work with their children in a supportive environment. Children must turn 5 on or before August 31, 2011 to participate.

Last Chance for Youth Soccer

Late sign-ups for spring youth soccer leagues are being accepted for children pre-k (going into kindergarten in the fall) thru 6th grade. In conjunction with the Division of Wildlife Services we will be sponsoring a youth fishing club for youth (participants must be 6 years old as of April 20, 2011) this spring at Clinton Pond. Classes begin Wednesday, April 20th and continue for 6 weeks. Participants will have ½ hour of instruction and 1 ½ hours of fishing time. Cost for residents is \$10, \$15 for non-residents and includes a t-shirt.
