PAY YOUR UTILITY BILL ONLINE:

Clinton City has a new online pay provider - XPRESS BILL PAY.

If you have previously used our online service and have not yet re-registered, you need to do so to create a new account. An Internet connection through a Web browser and an e-mail address is necessary. It's simple to use. Every month you receive a reminder e-mail to let you know your bill is online. Then, log in to your account at www.clintoncity.net or XpressBillPay.com and view your bill. When you're ready to pay your bill, select a payment type. You can pay with credit card, debit card, or electronic funds transfer. Then enter the information and you're done! Or, if you prefer, you can set up a recurring scheduled payment.



• **Air Tests Offered To Clinton Residents** - Hill AFB plans to test the air in Clinton homes this fall and winter as part of its continuing indoor air sampling program. In September, information packets were mailed to approximately 400 residents who live above the area of groundwater contamination located in the northeastern portion of Clinton. These packets include more detailed information about the indoor air sampling program and a postcard that residents can return if they wish to have their homes tested.

While not in the drinking water, chemicals found in the groundwater can evaporate and enter homes. Over the past few years, Hill has tested the air in more than 1,800 homes, including 221 in Clinton. Approximately 20 percent of the homes tested in Clinton have been found to have very low levels of chemical vapors. At the levels typically found, the vapors do not pose a health risk to residents, but to ensure residents' safety, the Air Force will work with residents to monitor and, if levels are above health based standards, install a system in the home to keep the vapors from entering. There is no cost to the resident for any of the actions taken as part of the air sampling program.

BE AN INFORMED CITIZEN

Clinton City has an existing ordinance dealing with "Solicitors, Peddlers, Vendors and Temporary Businesses" that requires all door to door sales representatives, solicitors, to have a valid Clinton City permit in order to solicit products door to door. This permit is to be worn by all door to door solicitors at all times while peddling their product. If you notice that a door to door solicitor is not wearing a badge please inform them that they are required to have a permit and refer them to the City Offices or contact the Police Department and they will enforce the ordinance.
