West Davis Corridor Update

We are continuing to study and analyze both Alternatives A and B in greater detail as part of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) in the coming months. This analysis includes studying both direct and indirect impacts for each alternative such as noise, water quality, and air quality. We are currently drafting chapters of the Draft EIS document, which will reflect the results of this in-depth analysis and will be available for public comment at the public hearings this fall.

SOLICITOR INFORMATION

Anyone soliciting in Clinton City, unless exempt from registration under Title 15-11-4 of the Clinton City Code of Ordinances, shall be registered with Clinton City. If the solicitor qualifies to solicit in Clinton City they shall be issued a Certificate and an Identification Badge. The Certificate shall list the name of the Registered Solicitor and the Responsible Person or Entity, if any, and the date on which the Certificate expires. The Certificate shall be dated and signed by the Business License Official. The Certificate shall be carried by the Registered Solicitor at all times while soliciting in the City. The City shall also issue each Registered Solicitor an Identification Badge that shall be worn prominently on his or her person while soliciting in the City. The Identification Badge shall bear the name of the City and shall contain: (a) the name of the Registered Solicitor; (b) address and phone number of the Registered Solicitor, or the name, address, and phone number of the Responsible Person or Entity is provided; (c) a recent photograph of the Registered Solicitor; (d) the date on which the Certificate expires.

If you encounter someone soliciting at your residence that does not have both a Certificate and an Identification Badge issued by Clinton City please contact Davis County Dispatch at (801) 451-4151.
