The Great Utah Shake Out

The State of Utah is planning an exercise drill simulating a 7.0 earthquake from April 17th thru April 19th of 2012. This will be a full-scale exercise that will test the Catastrophic Plan and the new State EOC (Emergency Operation Center) that was built next to the State Capital building. This is going to be the largest exercise drill in the history of our State. The majority of this exercise drill is going to be in the Salt Lake area with an exercise plan of 30,000 people injured and thousands missing.

We want to take this training exercise as a learning opportunity to improve our Emergency Operation Plan for Clinton City, teach and educate our kids at our local schools and at home, have positive neighborhood interaction, and update your home plans so that you are better able to provide for our families.

For your home emergency plans, here are some items you may want to review:

- Testing of 72 hour kits (food, water, clothing, medications, etc...)
- First aid kits
- Emergency meeting place
- Sheltering
- Neighborhood support
- Awareness of all utility shut offs around the home
- Pet care and supplies

We have met with all three Elementary School principals and they are supportive of participating in this exercise. This will help the kids become familiar with earthquake drills. It will include:

- Stop, drop, and cover drill
- Accountability of students
- Evacuation plan
- Emergency contacts updates with the school

You may want to register as a family for this exercise and really make it an educational and learning experience! The Fire Dept would also like to challenge those of you who already have 72 hour kits, to eat from them as a family for **one** meal. For those of you who don't have 72 hour kits, get or make some. COMPETITION BASEBALL LEAGUES: 4th/5th, 6th/7th, 8th/9th, 10th/11th Grade Boy's Leagues will be offered this season. Cost per team is \$500 4th-7th grade, and 8th/11th grade \$550 which includes regular season games, tournament and awards. 
