The Clinton City Fire Department is very excited to announce that we have received Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to upgrade and replace the Cardiac Monitor/Defibrillators on our first and second out Ambulances. In addition to the Cardiac Monitors/Defibrillators we also received a Chest Compression System. The approved project costs total \$78,083. The Federal share covers 90 percent of the total cost. With the help of this Grant the new equipment will give the Clinton City Fire Department the ability to provide fast, reliable, lifesaving, emergency cardiac care to the citizens we serve.



Heating Safety Tips

Heating equipment is a leading cause of home fire deaths. Almost half of home heating equipment fires are reported during the months of December, January, and February. Some simple steps can prevent most heating-related fires from happening.

Keep anything that can burn at least three feet away from heating equipment, like the furnace, fireplace, wood stove, or portable space heater.

Have a three-foot "kid-free zone" around open fires and space heaters.

Never use your oven to heat your home.

Have a qualified professional install stationary space heating equipment, water heaters or central heating equipment according to the local codes and manufacturer's instructions.

Have heating equipment and chimneys cleaned and inspected every year by a qualified professional.

Remember to turn portable heaters off when leaving the room or going to bed.

Always use the right kind of fuel, specified by the manufacturer, for fuel burning space heaters.

Make sure the fireplace has a sturdy screen to stop sparks from flying into the room. Ashes should be cool before putting them in a metal container. Keep the container a safe distance away from your home.

Test smoke alarms monthly.

- 2: Register at Clinton Recreation Offices OR on-line at: www.activityreg.com. Cost: \$10.00.
You must Pre-register. Attendance at field day class & range date is required to pass. After registration, begin on-line portion. May take 10-12 hrs to complete.
- 3: Attend field day class & Range day. Bring receipt from Clinton City, Voucher (License) all internet test or completion certificate to field day class. All test must be 100% correct. Bring your cased .22 rifle.
