### IMPORTANT INFORMATION.....

#### Business License Renewal Reminder...

All business licenses that have not been renewed prior to February 1, 2007 will be assessed a late fee. Clinton City Code of Ordinances states that business license fees for renewal businesses shall be due and payable on or before January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year and shall be delinquent after February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. All license fees not paid prior to February 1<sup>st</sup> shall have a penalty of 50 percent of the amount of the fee added to the original amount due. If the fee plus penalty is still not paid by March 1, a penalty of 75 percent of the amount of the fee shall be added to the original amount due. If the fee plus penalty is still not paid by April 1<sup>st</sup> then the business shall be considered to be operating without a business license in violation of this Chapter, subject to criminal prosecution for every day of operation after January 1<sup>st</sup> if a license is issued thereafter, the fee shall be double.

#### New Standards for Solicitors

Solicitor's doing business in the City of Clinton will be required to register with the city before doing business. Copies of the solicitor's ordinance, the registration information, and the fee amount can be obtained at the Community Development Department. For questions regarding this information feel free to contact the Community Development Department at 774-2620.

### CITY PROJECTS UPDATE

**Denver and Rio Grand Western RR Trail.** The contract for the construction of the trail from 2550 North to 300 North has been awarded and work will commence approximately March 5. The construction is programmed to take approximately 60 days and the end result will be a 10-foot wide asphalt trail. Parents, please teach your children to avoid this and other construction areas within the City.

**2000 West, 1300 North to 2300 North Widening.** Rocky Mountain Power has been busy relocating power poles on the project and the contract for construction is expected to be awarded in mid March. Construction will be throughout the year with desired completion before the snows fly again in November. Needless to say 2000 West will not be the route of choice for this year.

The Clinton Fire Department has taken delivery of a new 105 ft. Quint (Aerial) ladder apparatus. A Quint is an apparatus with five key features: a pump, a water tank, hose, ground ladders and an aerial device. This unit will provide a higher level of safety to our citizens as well as our firefighters and has an expected life of 20years. The department states that although no building in town is near the 100 ft. mark; the set back from the street to the buildings requires the extra length. By working with the manufacture (Smeal Fire Apparatus) the city was able to purchase a stock apparatus at a much reduced cost. The Fire Department in preparation for the new fire apparatus, has State Certified 80% of its personnel as Advanced Driver and Aerial Operators and 100% of the department on our specific apparatus by the manufacture.

The Quint should be in service by the middle of March.

### Adult Softball Sign-ups

The Clinton Recreation Department is currently accepting registrations for its upcoming summer, adult softball leagues. Co-ed, men's and women's leagues are available and registration will continue thru April 6<sup>TH</sup> or until leagues are filled, whichever comes first. League games will begin the week of May 14th.

### Youth Recreation Baseball and Softball Leagues

### Last Chance to Sign Up for Clinton Youth Soccer

Late sign-ups for our spring youth soccer leagues are currently being accepted at the Clinton City Recreation Department. Please call the Recreation Department to find out if there are openings in your child's age group. This soccer program is for children pre-school age (going into kindergarten in the fall or in kindergarten) through 6<sup>th</sup> grade. The fee with our late charge is \$50 for residents and \$65 for non-residents. The fee includes shirt, shorts, socks, and league play and practices. All games and practices are held on weeknights. ### Youth Fishing Club

The recreation department in conjunction with the Division of Wildlife Services will be sponsoring a youth fishing club this spring. Classes begin on Saturday, March 24<sup>th</sup> or Monday, March 26<sup>th</sup> and continue for 6 weeks. The Saturday class meets from 9:00 to 11:00 am and the Monday class meets from 6:00 to 8:00 pm. Participants will have ½ hour of instruction and 1 ½ hours of fishing time. Cost for residents is \$10 and non-residents is \$15 and include a t-shirt. Participants must be at least 6 years old as of March 24, 2007.

### Rookie League for 5 year olds

In conjunction with our youth baseball / softball program, Clinton Recreation will be offering a rookie league program for 5 year olds. The rookie league is a pre T-ball program designed to prepare children for the experience of organized T-ball. Children will learn the basic fundamentals of baseball and softball and develop the necessary skills to play and advance in organized baseball and softball programs. Parents will work together with their children in a supportive environment. Children must turn 5 years old on or before August 31, 2007 to be eligible.

### 55 and Older Activities

Our seniors program is for all residents 55 years and older and includes monthly luncheons and occasional trips to Utah areas of interest. ## Umpires and Concessionaires WANTED!

The Clinton Recreation Department is currently accepting applications for Umpires for our youth baseball and softball programs. Both adults and youth are encouraged to apply. Applicants must be 14 years of age or older as of May 14, 2007. Baseball and softball games are played primarily Monday through Friday in the evenings (4:30 or 5:00 pm to about 9:00 pm). Games will begin the week of May 14<sup>th</sup> and continue through July. Pay and number of games umpired per week will be based on testing, training, availability and skill level. Previous experience is not necessary. However a basic understanding of the sports of baseball and softball is helpful. All applicants will be provided with a packet of information on the program, rules and by-laws. Applicants will be tested on that information and all applicants passing the test will be enrolled in our training program. **COMPETITION BASEBALL LEAGUES:** 5/6th, 7/9th Grade Boy's Leagues will be offered this season. Cost is \$450, which includes regular season games, tournament and awards. Teams are required to supply their own coaches, scorekeeper, uniforms, rosters and equipment. A copy of a valid student ID or Birth Certificate, will be required with your official team roster. Play is on tuesday and thursday. For more info contact Ruth at 774-2666.  
(Clinton Teams may get help with uniforms and equipment.)

**ROOKIE PRE-T:** This Pre-T Ball program is designed to prepare young children for the experience of organized T-Ball. Children will learn the basic fundamentals of baseball/softball, and develop the necessary skills to play and advanced in organized baseball/softball programs. This is a hands on program where parents work together with their children in a supportive environment. Therefore, at least one parent/guardian/adult must accompany their child to all session/games. Your child must turn 5 by August 31, 2007. Due to the large amount of sign-ups, age requirements will be strictly enforced.

**TEAM INFORMATION:** Players will be assigned to teams in T-Ball and Pee Wee leagues by the Recreation Dept. All players in 3rd grade and up will be selected by the coaches in the player draft. This is not a try out, all youth registered will be assigned a team. The purpose of the draft is to balance the individual leagues, so they will be competitive within themselves.
