Sewer/Water Bill Increases

The City sewer costs are divided up into 2 separate areas: 1) the City cost of maintaining the system which collects the sewage and delivers it to the North Davis Sewer District's large interceptor piping system; and, 2) the payment to the Sewer District for them taking our local sewage into their system, transporting it to their Treatment Plant in Syracuse, and treating the sewage according to the state and federal standards. The North Davis Sewer District must expand their transport and treatment facilities. They are increasing their fees by \$3/per customer per month each year for the next 4 years to cover their expansion costs.

The City also needs to increase the monthly household cost by \$1 each for the City Water Fund and the City Sewer Fund in order to maintain the financial integrity of these Enterprise Funds. Thus, your July billing (which comes out in August) will reflect a \$1 increase in the Water costs and a \$4 increase in the Sewer costs (this includes the pass through North Davis Sewer costs).

In addition, **Delinquent Utility Payment Penalty** will increase from \$3.00 to \$ 10.00, effective 07/01/2014.

Over Hanging Tree Limbs - Residents, please remember to trim up trees that have branches over hanging the sidewalks and street areas next to your property. Sidewalks require a clearance of 8 feet and street areas a clearance of 12 feet (measured from the top of the curb). Please save the City in time and money from seeking compliance of these clearance standards. New tree foliage may look nice, but safe passage has to come first.

Street Weeds

We are having a banner weed growth this year. Many of our City streets are sprouting weeds along the edges between the concrete curb and asphalt street. As time and budget permit, we try to spray certain areas to kill these weeds, for their roots widen the gap between the curb and street allowing for further erosion, street cracking and asphalt breakage. We welcome your help in spraying and cleaning out the grass and weeds growing along the street curb line. Not only does the weed removal help the condition of the street, it also improves the aesthetics of your yard. Thank you!

**FIREWORKS SAFETY**

The safest way to enjoy the thrill of fireworks is to attend a public fireworks display. However, for fireworks enthusiasts who enjoy shooting their own; please pay particular attention to safety recommendations and safety tips from manufacturers and retailers who sell fireworks. Purchase fireworks from reliable, licensed fireworks dealers. Read all instructions to reduce the chances of a destructive fire or debilitating injury.

- Follow all safety guidelines exactly.
- Always provide adult supervision. Children under 16 years of age should not handle or light fireworks.
- Adults should never use alcohol or drugs or be impaired while engaged in handling, using, placing or lighting fireworks.
- New aerial type fireworks are now lawful. Aerial devices, also known as "multiple tube", "repeater", or "cake" fireworks often look like miniature professional displays and can travel high into the air, as much as 150 feet.

Please remember State Law allows the discharge of fireworks 3 days before and 3 days after the 4th and 24th of July between the hours of 11 a.m. and 11 p.m. except on July 4th and July 24th the hours are 11 a.m. to Midnight. You can also discharge fireworks on New Year's Eve and Chinese New Year between the hours of 11 a.m. and 1 a.m.

Rising temperatures and low humidity = prime fire conditions. Please be aware of your surroundings and use common sense while using fireworks. Have a safe and happy holiday celebration.
