Barbara Patterson has been selected by the City Council to fill the vacancy left by Councilmember Reed. Barbara has previously served on the Planning Commission and the City Council. She was a candidate in the 2013 Municipal Election and only lost by a few votes. Councilmember Patterson's term will end in December 2015.

The City Council recently passed Ordinance 04-02, amending Title 19-9-9(5) of the Clinton City Code. The new Ordinance states: Dogs may be walked on a leash along the following trails and walkways: Clinton City Creek trail; Powerline Park walkway; Clinton Rail Trail; Clinton Pond walkway, Clinton City Park walkway, and Kestrel Park walkway.

Dog owners are required to carry their own bags and clean up after their pets. The City Council will reevaluate the ordinance again in a few months to determine that the pet owners are acting responsibly and keeping the trails and pathways clean. Thank you.
