## ROAD CONSTRUCTION 3000 WEST 2300 NORTH

The City will be starting the 3000 W / 4300 W - 1400 N to 6000 S street construction project in January. It will begin with the construction of a box culvert to replace the bridge on 2300 N that crosses the Layton Canal just west of 3000 West. Additionally this phase will replace the siphon, located at approximately 2450 North 3000 West and the northwest end of Pond Park, with a box culvert. This construction will completely close off 2300 North just west of 3000 West and will severely restrict north south traffic across 2300 North at 3000 West during portions of this construction. Electronic notification signs of the construction will be placed in the area prior to closures and the closure of 2300 North at the canal is expected to last at least three weeks with other periods of blockage and slow down. This phase of the project will also be installing an upsized secondary water main from 2300 North to 2415 North along 3000 West and then both secondary and culinary water mains will be extended north along 3000 West north of 2415 North. The construction of this project must be done during the fall and winter when irrigation water is out of the Layton Canal. Once construction begins please avoid the area when possible, observe all flaggers and traffic caution signs, and instruct your children to stay out of construction areas.

### RED CROSS WINTER SAFETY TIPS

1. Wear layers of lightweight clothing, a hat and gloves to stay warm.
2. Don't forget your pets - bring them indoors or provide enough shelter to keep them warm give them access to unfrozen water.
3. Protect your pipes - run a trickle of water to help prevent your pipes from freezing. Open the kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors to allow warmer air to circulate around the plumbing. Be sure to move any harmful cleaners and household chemicals out of the reach of children. Keep the garage doors closed.
4. Keep the thermostat at the same temperature to help avoid freezing pipes.
5. If you are using a space heater, place it on a level, hard surface at least three feet from things such as paper, clothing, bedding, curtains or rugs.
6. Turn off space heaters and make sure fireplace embers are out before bed.
7. Never use a stove or oven to heat your home.
8. Use a glass or metal fireplace screen large enough to catch sparks and rolling logs.
9. Never operate a generator inside the home, including in the basement or garage.
10. Don't hook a generator up to the home's wiring. The safest thing to do is to connect the equipment you want to power directly to the outlets on the generator.
