

Doggy Issues

Please remember to take a plastic baggie with you when you walk your dog(s) and do not leave dog droppings behind. Also, dogs must be under the owners control on a leash at all times. Please do not allow dogs to wander on other resident's lawns.

Sidewalk Parking Lots

Property owners are required by law to keep the sidewalks adjacent to their property clear of debris, vehicles, snow, impeding tree/shrub overhang, etc.... Vehicles in driveways are not allowed to overhang on the sidewalk area.

Garbage Cans in Street

Garbage cans may be placed curbside in the street no sooner than the night before your pickup day. The cans must be removed from the curb by the evening of your pickup day.

Playing in the Street

No basketball hoops are allowed in the street or in the park strip areas. Playing in the street is prohibited by law. Keep your families safe. Please keep them out of the street areas.

In conjunction with the new trail/walkway on 1000 West, some residents in the City have proposed to line the street between 1800 N and 2300 N on 1000 W (east side) with a long row of American Flags. ### Swimming Lessons

Swimming lessons will be held for boys and girls 8 years and older at the Clearfield Pool. The cost is \$35 for Clinton residents and \$45 for non-residents. The lessons will begin Friday, June 8<sup>th</sup> and continue for 8 sessions through July 27<sup>th</sup>. Transportation is available.

### Tennis Lessons

Tennis lessons will be offered in two sessions for boys and girls ages 7 - 16 for beginners and intermediate/advanced players. The first session will run June 4<sup>th</sup> thru June 15<sup>th</sup>, Monday thru Friday. Beginner's class will be 9:00 – 10:00 a.m. and intermediate will be 10:00 – 11:00 a.m. The second session will run July 9<sup>th</sup> thru July 20<sup>th</sup> (same times as listed above). The lessons will be held at the Clinton City Park courts and the cost is \$30 for residents and \$40 for non-residents.

### Tumbling Lessons

Clinton City, in conjunction with "Head Over Heels" is offering tumbling classes for ages 18 months to 16 years old. The classes will run June 4<sup>th</sup> thru June 22<sup>nd</sup> and July 2<sup>nd</sup> thru July 18<sup>th</sup>. Cost is \$30 for residents and \$40 for non-residents. Space is limited, so sign up early. For more information contact Clinton City Recreation Department at 774-2666.

### Dance Lessons

Clinton City in conjunction with Rhythm Works Dance Studio, will be offering Jazz, Ballet, Hip-Hop and Cheer classes. The cost is \$30 for residents and \$40 for non-residents. See your summer brochure for dates and times.

### Golf Lessons and Golf Camp

Classes will be held at Schneider's Bluff in West Point for ages 7 to 16 on Wednesdays, June 6<sup>th</sup> to July 11<sup>th</sup>, (no classes July 4<sup>th</sup>) from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. The cost is \$35 for residents and \$45 for non-residents. Participants will be transported by bus. Clubs will be provided if the participant does not have any. Buses will pickup at 9:30 a.m. and drop off at 11:30 a.m.

We will also be hosting a **golf Camp** that is ideal for year round school students. The golf camp meets Monday thru Thursday from 10:00 – 11:15 a.m. the week of July 16<sup>th</sup> - July 19<sup>th</sup>. Transportation is also provided for this camp.

## Kids in the Park

Kids in the Park is a summer recreation program for children ages 5-13 years old. The program meets Monday thru Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at the Clinton City Park and children participate in a wide variety of activities including sports and games, field trips, arts and crafts, and water games. The program runs June 4<sup>th</sup> thru August 9<sup>th</sup> and is very well supervised. Children may sign up to participate all summer long or on a monthly or daily basis. Cost for the entire summer is \$150 for Clinton City residents and \$175 for non-residents. Family discounts are available and additional information may be obtained by calling the Clinton City Recreation Department at 774-2666.

### Start Smart

Clinton City Recreation is accepting registrations for a Start Smart Program, a sports readiness program for four-year olds. The Start Smart program is a great alternative to organized sports for kids and parents looking to start sports at a young age. Start Smart is designed to help young children develop basic motor skills competence and confidence so they can take the next step into organized sports. The cost is \$30 for Clinton City residents and \$45 for non-residents. Sign up at the Clinton City offices at 1906 West 1800 North. Participants must be 4 years old as of Aug 31, 2007. The session will run June 5– 21 on Tues and Thurs evenings.
