SIGN UP FOR EMERGENCY CONTACT & NOTIFICATIONS

Clinton City now has an emergency contact and notification system. To sign up, click on the **Red Phone** (below) to follow the link to our website at www.clintoncity.com to register.

or, go to the website and click on the **Red Phone** to sign up. By registering, you can specify how you will receive notifications and you can keep your profile updated with accurate contact information to insure you are notified of important information or an emergency.

Please note that our Emergency Contact System is automatically and regularly updated through our Utility Billing system. If your information on file is not accurate, and you have not registered on our website, you may not receive EMERGENCY NOTICES through our system. Please call our Utilities Department at 801-614-0700 to update your information.

If you are an owner of a rental property, please encourage your renters to register for notifications on our website.

When registering, please make sure to respond to the verification email to complete the registration process.

There are several accounts that have not completed the process by responding to this email. In an effort to contact these account owners to complete the registration process, the verification e-mail will be resent on March 5. Please take the time to check your e-mail including the junk mail folder on that day and if you receive a verification email from Cloudspeaker (the provider) please respond to it to complete your registration and check your security settings to allow future messages to be delivered to your in box in the future.

The Clinton City Parks department is seeking qualified applicants to fill several seasonal positions for the 2015 summer season. Employment generally lasts from June to August, in some cases longer, depending on individual schedules. Applicants must be at least 16 years old, and must possess a valid driver's license. Applicants must also submit to and, pass a drug and alcohol test. ALL applicants MUST be willing to work well with others. Starting wage is \$8.00/hr. Those with more experience may qualify for more.
