**West Davis Corridor Update (UDOT)**

The WDC team is continuing to study and analyze the alternatives in greater detail as it completes the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) document. The DEIS will contain all the data, analysis, public input and technical information the study team has collected and studied through the past three years. The DEIS will also identify UDOT's locally preferred alternative. The DEIS is expected to be released later this spring, along with a public hearing process and formal comment period. A final Record of Decision on an alternative is not expected until the study is complete in 2014.
