### ONLINE HUNTER SAFETY CLASSES

### Air Tests Offered To Clinton Residents

Hill AFB plans to test the air in homes within the city of Clinton this fall and winter as part of its continuing indoor air sampling program. In October, information packets were mailed to approximately 385 residents who live above the area of groundwater contamination located in the northeastern portion of Clinton. These packets included detailed information about the indoor air sampling program and a postcard that residents can return if they wish to have their homes tested.

While not in the drinking water, chemicals found in the groundwater can evaporate and enter homes. Over the past few years, Hill has tested the air in more than 1,900 homes, including 247 in Clinton. Of those 247 homes approximately 10 percent have been found to have very low levels of chemical vapors. At the levels typically found, the vapors do not pose a health risk to residents. To ensure residents' safety, the Air Force will work with residents to monitor the vapor levels. If levels are above health-based standards, the Air Force will install a system in the home to keep the vapors from entering. There is no cost to residents for any of the actions taken as part of the air sampling program.
