WEST DAVIS CORRIDOR

The WDC team is continuing to study and analyze the alternatives in greater detail as it prepares the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) document. Chapters of the Draft EIS document are being written and the team is conducting a comprehensive analysis on various environmental impacts. The results of this in-depth analysis will be presented in the Draft EIS as well as UDOT's preferred alternative. This information is expected to be released in spring 2013 along with a public hearing process and formal comment period. A final Record of Decision is not expected until the study is complete in 2014. - 2: REGISTER AT CLINTON RECREATION OFFICES OR ON-LINE AT: WWW.ACTIVITYREG.COM. COST: \$10.00. YOU MUST PRE-REGISTER. ATTENDANCE AT FIELD DAY CLASS & RANGE DATE IS REQUIRED TO PASS. AFTER REGISTRATION, BEGIN ON-LINE PORTION. MAY TAKE 10-12 HRS TO COMPLETE.
