

CLINTON 3000 WEST & HOOPER 4300 WEST ROADWAY PROJECT

Construction on 3000 West is underway and will continue through fall 2015. The project will reconstruct 3000 West between 1400 North and 2415 North (Clinton Pond). 3000 West will be extended northward on a new alignment between Clinton Pond and connect to 4300 West in Roy/Hooper at 6000 South.

During construction, traffic access will be maintained as much as possible, however, motorists should expect restrictions, road closures and travel delays in the work zone and are advised to use alternate routes. The intersection of 2300 North/3000 West will be closed for approximately a month for construction of a roundabout.

The cities of Syracuse and West Point are also reconstructing 3000 West from Bluff Road in Syracuse to 1400 North in Clinton. Drivers should expect roadwork and traffic restrictions through these areas as well.

SCHEDULE

- Right-of-way clearing (fence and tree removals) and storm drain construction are expected to begin the week of April 6. Major roadway work is expected to begin by mid-April.
- Crews plan to work Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., however, weekend work is possible.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACT NOTES FOR RESIDENTS

- Student bussing and walking routes may be modified to facilitate construction and are being coordinated with the affected schools and school district. Individual principals and the district transportation department will coordinate changes with affected residents.
- The contractor will provide advance notice and coordinate individually with residents who may be affected by temporary driveway closures to facilitate the work. Street-side parking is prohibited in closed areas. Sidewalk closures are also possible.
- Garbage pick-up and mail delivery will be maintained and coordinated by the contractor.
- Utility service interruptions are not planned for current phases of work but due to the nature of roadway excavation, unplanned service interruptions are possible. The contractor will provide advance notice of any planned service interruptions.
- Every reasonable effort will be made to minimize construction dust, noise, and vibration and to complete the project as quickly as possible. Residents and commuters are asked to be patient during construction.
- Road construction involves open trenches and heavy construction equipment. To maintain safety in the work zone, residents are asked to avoid open trenches and take appropriate safety measures with children.
- Fines for traffic violations through construction zones are significant. Drivers are encouraged to follow all signs and flaggers through work zones to promote public safety.


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PROJECT AREA MAP
