



CLINTON 3000 WEST & HOOPER 4300 WEST ROADWAY PROJECT

April 2015

DEAR PARENTS,

Road construction is underway on 3000 West and will continue through fall 2015. The project will reconstruct 3000 West between 1400 North and 2415 North (Clinton Pond). 3000 West will be extended northward on a new alignment between Clinton Pond and connect to 4300 West in Roy/Hooper at 6000 South. A new roundabout will be constructed at the 2300 North intersection in Clinton.

During construction, traffic access will be maintained as much as possible, however, motorists should expect restrictions, road closures and travel delays in the work zone and are advised to use alternate routes. With prior notice, the intersection of 2300 North/3000 West will be closed for approximately one month for roundabout construction.

The cities of Syracuse and West Point are also reconstructing 3000 West from Bluff Road in Syracuse to 1400 North in Clinton. Drivers should expect roadwork and traffic restrictions through these areas as well.

The work involves open trenches and heavy construction equipment. Student bussing and walking routes may be modified to facilitate construction and are being coordinated with the affected schools and school district. Individual principals and the district transportation department will coordinate changes with affected residents.

Drivers are advised to carpool when possible, use alternate routes and plan for extra time when traveling through the work zone, especially the 2300 North intersection. On-street parking is prohibited in the work zone.

We want you and your family to be safe during construction. Please take a moment to go over these three safety tips with your children. Remind them that although it's fun to watch crews at work, it's important to watch from far away where there is no danger of getting hurt. Also, remind them to walk or ride bikes far away from construction zones and large machines to stay safe.



THREE TIPS FOR STAYING SAFE!

1 BE AWARE of your surroundings. Workers in big trucks and other equipment can't see you as well as you can see them.


2 AVOID THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE Sometimes the shortest route isn't the safest one.
