

2300 NORTH STREET RECONSTRUCTION AND WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

On approximately May 1st crews will begin constructing a new waterline on 2300 North between 500 West and 1000 West. This is the 2nd phase of a 3 phase project which when completed will be a major improvement to water pressure and flows and it will provide an additional source of water into the city. This phase of the project is expected to be substantially complete by early July 2018. Once the waterline is installed the full width of the street will be repaved and additional improvements made to storm drain boxes and damaged sections of curb. All of the pedestrian curb ramps will be upgraded to current American Disabilities Act Standards.

2300 North Street is narrower than a typical collector street so to provide for the safety of construction crews and the travelling public, the street will be closed to thru traffic during the day normally between 7am and 6pm M-F. Homes within the construction area will be accessible. Interruptions in water service will happen as new connections are made, the crew will give notice in advance of any shut downs.
