

UOCAVA Notice

The Uniformed And Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) NOTICE

The City of Clinton will hold a Municipal General Election on November 2, 2021 to elect the following offices:

Mayor (4-year term)

Two (2) City Council positions (4-year term)

The candidate filing period is between June 1, 2021, and June 7, 2021, Monday through Friday, except weekends and holidays. A Declaration of Candidacy must be filed in person from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the City Recorder's office, 2267 N 1500 W, Clinton. A \$25.00 filing fee is required to file.

Candidates must meet the following qualifications: 1. A United States Citizen, 2. a registered voter of the City. 3. The individual must have resided within Clinton City for at least 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of election. 4. Not be a convicted felon, unless their right to hold elective office has been restored as provided by statute. Each elected officer of a municipality must maintain a principal place of residency within the municipality, and within the district that the elected officer represents, during their term of office.

A primary election shall be held, if necessary, on August 10, 2021. Utah Code Annotated §10-3-301.

If you are an absent military or overseas citizen eligible to vote in state and local elections, you may register to vote and request a regular absentee ballot for upcoming elections.
