PUBLIC WORKS SUMMER EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

The Clinton City Parks department is seeking qualified applicants to fill several seasonal positions for the 2019 summer season. Employment generally starts from March to October. However, consideration to school and other schedules will be reasonably accommodated. Applicants must be at least 16 years old, and must possess a valid driver's license. Applicants must also submit to and, pass a drug and alcohol test. ALL applicants MUST be willing to work well with others. Starting wage is \$9.50/hr. Those with more experience may qualify for more.

- 1- Mowing crew
- 2- Ball Field prep/maintenance crew
- 3- Flower Beds/ aesthetics crew
- 4- Sprinklers crew
- 5- Parks maintenance crew
- 6- Flower Pot watering crew (morning and afternoon positions available)
- 7- Weekend work

If you are an owner of a rental property, please encourage your renters to register on our website to receive emergency notifications. When registering, please make sure to respond to the verification email to complete the registration process.

BUSINESS LICENSE FEES

Late fees for business license renewals increased on March 1, 2019. In addition to the original amount due a penalty of 75 percent of the amount of the fee will be added.

All businesses are required to submit a renewal application even if the fee exemption qualification is met.

*If you are no longer operating a business please contact the Clinton City Community Development Department at 801-614-0740, so we can remove your information from our active files. Failure to contact our office may result in a citation being issued for operating a business without a current license.

Tree/Shrub Trimming Reminder: It is the homeowner's responsibility to maintain all trees and shrubs in their park strip. Please get them trimmed now so that the street sweeper can sweep your street this summer. The City Code (25-16-5) states: "All shrubs and trees shall be pruned to permit plain view of regulatory (street and stop) and caution signs, utility accesses, and so that they do not overhang the curb in the street twelve (12) feet or the sidewalk eight (8) feet."
